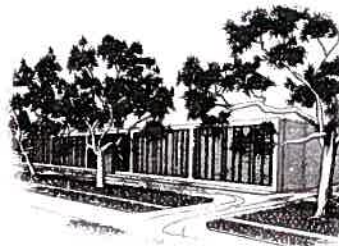

have elected to convert their practices to a new model of medicine which limits the number of active patients in his/her practice to 600. These physicians, while continuing to practice and be partner-physicians at Medical Clinic of Houston, will practice under this new model developed by MDVIP, Inc. which has 350 affiliated physicians in the United States.

All other physicians at MCH, including nineteen general internal medicine physicians and eleven sub-specialists, will continue to practice traditional medicine as always.

If You Are a Patient of One of These Six Physicians, You Have a Decision to Make

You will be receiving detailed information from your physician in the near future. This information will outline the benefits of enrolling in your physician's *new* practice – the MDVIP model. Enrollees will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. If you have questions about this announcement, feel free to ask questions during your next visit or call your physician's office. Regardless of this upcoming change, your current physician will be available to see you, as always, until the end of 2010.

If you choose not to enroll in your physician's MDVIP practice, be assured that we have many excellent general internists to ensure continuity of care for you. Your physician will be happy to personally recommend another MCH physician for you based on your medical needs, personal desires, and health plan coverage. In addition to the fourteen other internal medicine physicians currently practicing at MCH, five internists will be joining MCH this summer. As you have come to expect, all of the physicians joining us are talented, board-certified or board-eligible internists – some were members of the faculty at one of the medical schools in Houston and have smaller traditional practices with plenty of room to grow, the others are recent graduates of some of the top medical schools and training programs in the country. Additionally, we are looking for three to four additional top candidates with hopes of having them on board by January 1, 2011.
